- Wed 17 Rained this morning for a short time. Willie came over for a visit and but our Mail. Fred put in half a day cloudy towards evening.
- Thu 18 Rained this morning but cleared up towards noon. I went over to B. 2 1/2 where it stays. Fred took him things with the team.
- Fri 19 A fine clear day. Fred at work, I'm busy in the garden, I put in a few potatoes.
- Sat 20 Cold last night but a fine clear day. A few light showers in afternoon. I drove over and got the Mail. Fred as before.
- Sun 21 A fine warm day. ~~Benji~~ and Willie camped here and over to a few showers towards evening.
