THURSDAY 20

(294-72)

1904

The Indians started back this morning Joseph & John started down the river on a raft & clear water in river
Thomas started this afternoon
Expelled with the Indians arrived this evening from the north river

FRIDAY 21

(295-71)

Joseph & Samson started down the river with a few supplies for Joseph and a few barrels
A fine mild day

SATURDAY 22

(296-70)

A fine day, Joseph & Samson arrived at some point & passed by
Samson by boat job
Indians passed off
Sunday 23
Boat of at their traps
A fine warm day
