Monday 18

Stormy with snow self in office Mr. Battenman in office a lot of people arrived

Tuesday 19

A fine mild day but cloudy and water like snow. Mr. Battenman left this morning with the mail man for Jacksons Hope. self at old jobs

Wednesday 20

22 below 2 this morning self cutting fire wood on Island the boys hauling hay cold all day
