Christmas day a few of the
settlers around 42 below zero
this morning and continued
cold all day

Tuesday 26

very cold 46 below this morning
self at odd jobs Joe Appassien
& the young wife arrived from
Cub Lake River

Wednesday 27

continues very cold 50 below zero
this morning self busy in store
with Indians hedge meat for a
load of hay from the Ranch

Thursday 28

a little milder 25 below 2 this morning
Joe Appassien & the wife left this
morning self cutting fire wood
George hauling wood
