Saturday 3

Cloudy and looks like snow  
Yakatchu & 3 others arrived and  
brought a few Pans. The Badenhead  
Brothers and from Dunsmuir.  
They had to leave their pack on account  
of ice. River rising

Sunday 4

A fine clear day self set out  
a few traps. Run with Indians  
for a while

Monday 5 1917

a fine clear day self in  
office. George went down with  
the team & H Philip to get them  
shod. River coming up fast

Tuesday 6

Continues fine weather self in office  
H Philip saw 12 horses across the  
River this afternoon

Wednesday 7

weather continues fine self very  
busy. I cleaned all the stove pipes  
in the house and fixed up  
the stove. D H Taylor passed up the  
River on a Peepan hunt. Johny  
& Angus went up the hill to blow
