A canoe arrived from P.R.G. with a Police Doctor on his way to St. Lawrence. I kept a sharp eye on him as it is late in the season and no one to take him through.

TUESDAY 4

(917-119)

Sold to Samson and a Kay. Babson went after House.
2 Indian boys arrived from Apinac Camp.
Rain all night.
Boat out to house, arrived.

WEDNESDAY 5

(918-117)

Worked over since this morning. This makes the 8th death anniversary of the 3rd year this summer.
Apinac & Police & Kay arrived also yesterday & Kay today with Indians.

SEPTEMBER

THURSDAY 6

(919-110)

1906

The boat started down the river this morning having been unable to get past the falls on St. Lawrence.
Started to rain to much evening. Rain arrived.

FRIDAY 7

(920-110)

Five Indians arrived. Long with Indians. See diary. Samson and family left.
Started to rain towards evening. The 5 P.P. boys came from the mountains. Mr. Richardson arrived from Reservoir. Rain.

SATURDAY 8

(921-110)

Rain all day. Lining at water falls. James & Helen arrived from St. Marys. Rain morning & evening.
