Sunday 2
23 below this morning

Monday 3
Constant cold 23 below again this A.M. Talwan Ben & 2 others arrived from the west end of C. Lake & brought a few deer. They are skin very little in the fur line. A Mr. MacLean arrived with 100 head cattle he has taken them up to Beards

Tuesday 4
12 below this morning a light fall of snow the Indians left this morning Mr. Fraser and J.D. Goodhead arrived

Wednesday 5
A fine clear day but cold 20 below this morning the mail arrived from Pense Camp. a few people arrived self in store

Thursday 6
31 below this morning the mail left for out self at odd jobs

Friday 7
7 below this morning but a fine clear day self at odd jobs

Saturday 8
Cloudy and overcast looks like snow self cutting firewood
