dressed above the branch. Boots left
for Spout Ridge

Thursday 18
mail arrived this evening
weather fine self very busy
Ted Purser came in with the mail

Friday 19
mail left this morning continued
fine

Saturday 20
Charles Fisher & J. Doolin from Pt
Nelson and brought a few boxes
self very busy in store

Sunday 21
busy with Doolin's Doolin left after
dinner with my loads started to
snow towards evening and continued
all night
