King they camped here for the night.

Tuesday 29

Cloudy with a few showers all day. The D.A. Thomas passed down about 10⁰⁰ this morning with a lot of wheat a few passengers went down with her. We planted a few potatoes this evening. Wabbee and his wife down for a visit.

Wednesday 30

A fine clear day. Self working in the garden. put in some cition and Squash this evening. A Sheavers Boat arrived from H. Hope about 6 PM and left for Taylor Boat to load Grain.
