Friday 15

30 below this morning but fine all day. Cold towards evening. Miller went up after dinner. R. Thompson sawing fire wood all day. Left bus at 10 jobs. 20 below at 10. There was a dance at Thorsens this evening.

Saturday 16

Cold and strong with snow wind from north and still strong to night at 10. A blizzard all roads will be drifted over. 18 below 2.

Sunday 17

Continues cold and stormy as yesterday, no trail open. 30 below 2. This evening cleared up about 8 PM but very cold. Wind went towards the west. Jan Savard and the Belier interpreter was married this evening by Mr Beckel.

Monday 18

40 below this morning cold all day and very clear. I was busy making trails and at 10 jobs. Miller came down this evening with the trail. Mr. Blanks + Mrs. Blanks and Interpreter and wife left this morning for Fort Nelson.
