October 1936

Thursday 1

Cloudy and overcast but cleared towards evening the Boys took the Potatoes in from the field Johnny took some letters over to the P. office. Thomas started to think after dinner.

Friday 2

Very Cloudy all day but cleared a little this evening. I was busy taking in our Cabbages & Crows. Fred cut some fine wood in the bush. I also found our new Well it is full of water.
