Thursday 28

Snowed about 2 in very cloudy this morning cleared up before noon and started to blow a strong gale from the west and turned very warm most of the snow gone by evening I drove over to the H.B. store after dinner the roads very wet

Friday 29

A fine clear day I had a visit from the Wolf and a Boy with him and we had a visit from Mr. Brown this evening the snow nearly all gone
